There is more than one way to support our garden. Different opportunities are available depending on your interest, skill set, and schedule.

Type of Service	Description	Examples
Direct	Perform work in the garden, in the classroom, or at the school. Often involves face-to-face interaction with students, teachers, or parents.	Plant Garden Pull weeds Cook; clean/setup Lead PA at recess Welcome volunteers at the sign-in table; staff table at school events
Indirect	Provide services or support for the primary work.	Fundraise Bring in help Create flyer; decorate bulletin board Donate tools, cooking utensils, jump ropes, supplies.
Advocacy	Create awareness or promote action in an area of interest.	Present to school board Engage PTA/O/Parent Groups Reach out to community Present to student council Host a meeting
Research	Find, gather, and report on information.	Identify needs Investigate resources Find out how much needed items cost, where you can buy them or get them for free
